Driver EDge will be in Vauxhall April 2021 to offer our program!
Depending on the Covid-19 restrictions.

Classroom session will run April 19-22, 2021, Monday – Thursday 3:30 – 5:30 & 6:00 – 8:15 PM at the Vauxhall High School. In-Vehicle Drive times will be scheduled prior and during the classroom session.

Course consists of **17 hours of classroom instruction** and **10 hours of in-vehicle instruction**. We do 6 hours of the in-vehicle lessons in Vauxhall and then 4 hours in Lethbridge to do some city driving. (Students will have to provide their own transportation to Lethbridge to meet the instructor) More lessons can be scheduled in Lethbridge if you wish to have more city driving. Please indicate if you are wanting more city driving.


