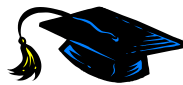

YEARBOOK

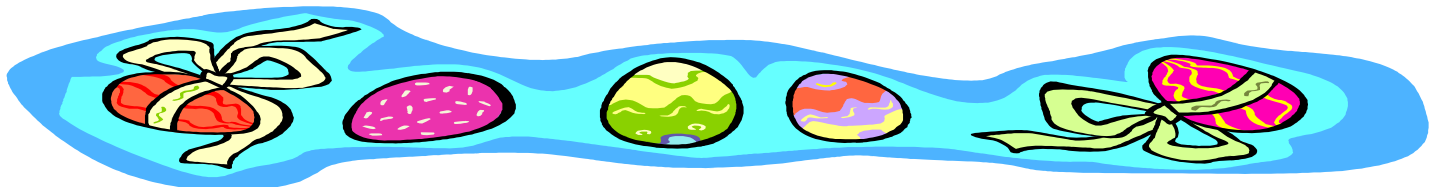
Grads have until April 1st to purchase a yearbook if they would like their names engraved on it at no extra charge. Yearbooks can be purchased at the office for only \$30.
